Historically 1952 was a great year! The Academy Awards, the Today Show and the Honeymooners all debuted! The NY Yankees defeated the Brooklyn Dodgers in the World Series. In the fall of 1951, after thirty three years in the day camp business, our family purchased the beautiful three hundred plus acres atop Mount Delight on the shores of stunning Lake Wentworth. Back then Birchmont was a small farm where families could rent cabins, hike, swim, canoe, horseback ride and opt to join in on the meal plan. By the summer of 1952 Birchmont was transformed into a private resident camp and the new *home away from home* for 125 campers and a few dozen staff.

So much has changed since that first day 60 years ago, but thankfully the core experience of FUN, friendship and personal growth remain clearly in focus. Each and every day we see great things happening all around camp. They can be small, such as a gesture of friendship shared between two campers, a group of kids excitedly reliving the latest inter-camp competition or the excitement that can be generated from a simple old fashioned game of tug of war on the 4th of July! Camp is so very different from the day to day lives we all lead the rest of the year. It's great to see the kids slow it down, unplug, and relax into the long camp day; after all, camp is the real meaning of 24/7!

We truly have had a great start. So many of our key staff from our directors and group leaders right through to our kitchen and maintenance staff have returned to make Birchmont the great place that it is! This year has seen lots of happy campers and the least amount of camper (and parent) homesickness that we can remember...


